



COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN

VENUE OPERATIONS

- All tennis club organisers are informed and kept up-to-date with the latest requirements and restrictions for participation and attendance at the venue.
- Signage has been installed near entrances and throughout venue outlining social distancing rules, etiquette and conditions of use.
- Conditions of entry are also published on the club website and facebook page.
- A hand sanitiser station has been installed and is located near court 2, free of charge.
- A professional cleaner has been hired to clean inside the clubhouse and high traffic areas including court gates and outdoor seating on a weekly basis, indefinitely.
- Organisers to record the contact details of all venue attendee to assist close contact tracing should it be required.
- All club related payments are to be made via EFT or ETPOS. No cash payments accepted.
- Casual court hire. Contact Picton Tennis Club for pin number access to court hire key.
- ALL COVID-19 cases MUST notify the Picton Tennis Club immediately

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Stay at home if you:

- Have been in contact with someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days
- Have been overseas or exposed to someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days
- Have flu-like symptoms
- Are in a high risk health category

Conditions of Participation

All players must observe the following conditions on the day which you are playing tennis.

ATTENDING TENNIS ACTIVITIES

- Only people core to playing or coaching should be on court or at the venue
- Arrive and leave as close as possible to when you need to be there.
- In order to comply with relevant Child Safety guidelines, preferably one parent/guardian should accompany younger children and continue to be present for the duration of the tennis activity.
- No socialising before or after play is permitted.
- No more than 4 people are allowed on one court



SOCIAL DISTANCING

- Touch racquets instead of the regular pre or post match handshakes
- Keep 1.5 metres away from other people while watching or attending a tennis activity

CLEAN ENVIRONMENT AND HYGIENE PRACTICES

- Wash/sterilise your hands before and after you play and avoid touching your face while playing
- Do not share water bottles. Bring your own full bottle
- Wash your hands frequently with soap and water or hand-sanitiser when available, before and after eating, after going to the toilet, sneezing, and coughing
- Cover your coughs and sneezes and dispose of any used tissue immediately
- Avoid touching your face
- Keep your distance from people who are obviously sick
- Do not share tennis racquets
- Hand washing and good hygiene signage is displayed at strategic points around the venue.
- Clean high traffic areas regularly with disinfectant solutions and disinfectant wipes that can be found in the clubhouse.

RECORD KEEPING

- We record the name and a contact number of all visitors for a period of at least 28 days.
- We ensure records are used only for the purposes of tracing COVID-19 infections and are stored confidentially and securely.
- It is the role of the COVID-19 Safe Hygiene Marshal to ensure the accuracy and legibility of records.

Any breaches or questions relating to the rules listed above are to be directed to the COVID-19 Safe Hygiene Marshal.
